We also inform you of the following rights you may exercise with regard to the Data Controller: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Right of access: You have the right, in accordance with Article 15 of the GDPR, to obtain from the Data Controller the access to your personal data. • Right to rectification: You have the right, in accordance with Article 16 of the GDPR, to request the rectification of personal data concerning you. • Right to erasure: You have the right, in accordance with Article 17 of the GDPR, to request the erasure of personal data concerning you. • Right to restriction: You have the right, in accordance with Article 18 of the GDPR, to obtain from the controller restriction of processing of your personal data. • Right to object: You have the right, in accordance with Article 21 of the GDPR, to object to the processing of your personal data. • Right to lodge a complaint: You have the right, in accordance with Article 77 of the GDPR, to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority. (e.g. the Data Protection Authority).
